Our Speaker Admiral Archie R. Clemins, U.S. Navy (Ret)

Mr. Clemins is a retired Admiral of the United States Navy and served as the 28th Commander of the Pacific Fleet, and as Commander in Chief from 1996 to 1999. His Flag Officer assignments included Deputy Commander of the United States Atlantic Fleet and Commander of the United States Seventh Fleet. He retired from active duty in December 1999. He has served on ballistic missile and attack submarines and commanded the USS POGY (SSN647). After his retirement, Admiral Clemins became the Founder, Owner, and President of Caribou Technologies, Inc., an innovative company that provides optimum solutions to governmental needs through the best commercial technologies. He also serves on the Governor's Science and Technology Advisory Committee for the State of Idaho. He received the B.S. degree, an M.S. in Electrical Engineering, and an Honorary Doctorate from the University of Illinois.
